

Financial Aid & Study Abroad Checklist



- All of your aid will carry with you since you are going on an Emory program. Meet with a financial aid advisor if you have questions regarding your aid or if you need to borrow a student or parent loan.
- Use OPUS to update your email address, billing, and contact information before you go abroad.
- Contact Student Accounts to make if you expect to receive a refund. Sign up for “direct deposit” under student financials on OPUS.
- If you have questions about your aid while abroad, contact Kalynn Wilczynski in the Financial Aid Office at knuoral@emory.edu. If you have questions about your student account, contact Bernice Kelley at bkelly@bursar.emory.edu

To apply for financial aid for the 2006-2007 academic year you must complete the following:

- Submit both the FAFSA and CSS Profile by March 1, 2006. **Both forms are due in our office by May 1, 2006.** You can apply online at www.collegeboard.com (PROFILE available after November 15) and at www.fafsa.ed.gov (FAFSA is available after Jan.1)
- Submit the parent and student 2005 federal tax returns, schedules and W2 statements to the Financial Aid Office by May 1, 2006. Your file must be complete before it will be reviewed for financial aid eligibility.
- Make sure that your financial aid application materials are submitted by the published deadlines. Filing late may reduce your grant eligibility.
