

STOP! Read this!! No REALLY read this!
Don't just glance and turn the page... READ THIS
These are things that need to be done BEFORE
you study abroad.... IMPORTANT THINGS,
things you *don't* want to forget about!

- CAMPUS MAIL: (memo included) Fill out a change of address form at the post office to have your mail forwarded –inside the US.
- Sort out PARKING: (memo included)- Return your permit for a partial refund... Will your insurance company allow you to “park” your car for a year? -save \$
- FINANCIAL AID checklist: information included
- DISABILITY SUPPORT SERVICES: (form included) – if you are registered with DDS, you need to return enclosed letter to your CIPA advisor- arrangements need to be made prior to arrival in your host country.
- HOUSING: On campus- Inform the Housing Office that you will not be here for next semester. Email Joni Tyson.
- PASSPORT/VISA Documentation
- DOCTOR'S and DENTIST'S APPOINTMENT/ CDC Hotline
- Check with your Personal Health Care Provider- are you covered abroad?!?
- Inquire if your current cell phone can be taken/used abroad
- If you are traveling to a remote area and will not have internet access, arrange for a friend or family member to register you for the following semester's classes
